Whether you are dreaming of being SA's next Top Designer, simply looking for a new and exciting skill or design hobby, or want to enhance your existing sewing or design skills, look no further, ÜberGlam is ready to instruct you in the art of creating dazzling clothing and accessories to suit your needs.

We offer full time or part time courses in sewing, patternmaking, accessories and fashion illustration. Our courses are flexible and specifically aimed at individuals who are eager to learn about fashion design and sewing without the stress of exams and overdue projects.

ÜberGlam offers a relaxed and friendly, yet professional atmosphere. Although we mainly offer adult courses and most of our students are in their 20's and 30's, we also have students in their teens and even in their 60's, and welcome anyone with a passion and desire to learn.

If you're a practicing designer or current design student, you can also benefit from our classes and courses as we offer a relaxed atmosphere where you can get practical assistance and ask questions, consult with peers, learn new skills and solve issues regarding client orders, design difficulties and design projects without any pressure.

We keep our classes small and intimate and we work with each individual at their own level and pace to ensure maximum learning and personal attention. We welcome beginners to advanced learners, working professionals, homemakers, mothers, grandmothers, children, practicing designers, as well as part time and full time students. Our foreign students from various countries around the globe also bring an interesting mix to our classes.

From basic adult sewing classes to patternmaking classes to advanced design classes, one of our fashion courses will appeal to you. You are also invited to browse through our website www.uberglam.co.za and to join us to discover your inner artist and designer.

Whether you see yourself as a future designer, or simply looking for a new hobby, skill, or need to brush up on existing sewing and design techniques, at ÜberGlam we can assist you with all of this.

Whether you're a working professional, teen, stay-at-home mom, young upcoming designer or foreigner - anyone with a passion to learn is welcome! I strive to assist you patiently and professionally and work with your individual design and sewing needs. I keep the classes small and work with everyone at their own level and pace to ensure maximum learning, so you never have to worry about waiting for or falling behind with the rest the class!

We provide a comfortable and relaxing, yet professional environment without the stresses of exams and projects. Our main focus is skills development and preparing students practically for those who want to start their own business or those only interested in a recreational skill/hobby.

For all the courses, the classes, duration and costs are mostly based on 1 x class per week (2.5hours per class). We don't have classes on public holidays and we have brief holiday periods between the terms, some months have 4 weeks and others 5, but the total cost of the course is divided into 5 months or 10 months for those who would prefer to pay it off monthly, and the monthly payments are calculated at an average of 4 classes per month.

You are also able to do the courses in a shorter period of time if you want to. So, at ÜberGlam you can set your own pace. Eg. the design & construction course is +-10 months if you do 1 x class per week, but you could do it in +-5 months if you do 2 x classes per week, or +-2 ½ months if you do 4 x classes per week, etc)

The monthly fees are then adjusted according to the amount of classes you have per week so that the full amount is paid up by the time you finish with your course. Or if the upfront payment option is chosen then arrangements can be made when you register, to attend more classes per week in order to finish the course much quicker.

Some of the students complete everything that interests them in one year in order to start up their own business much quicker or simply focus on their business target.

Course information:

Duration:

The duration of the course depends on what type of course you are interested in (see details below).

You can choose which course/s interests you and only do those. The course fees and duration is mostly based on 1 class per week but you are welcome to do the course in a shorter period by signing up for more than one class per week, depending on your time availability, budget and preference. Naturally if more classes are attended per week, the course will be finished in a shorter period and therefore the monthly fees are then increased to the amount of classes you would like to do per month.

Courses may be paid monthly in advance, or as a once-off (see discount options for up-front payment). Monthly installments are strictly payable by the last day of each month for the following month. Penalty charges of 5% is added to fees for late monthly payment.

Once you have enrolled for a course your space is kept for you for the full duration of the course in the class/es that you have selected on your registration form, and you are contractually bound for payment of the full duration of the course. No refunds will be issued and classes that are not attended will be forfeited at the student's own expense. **No catch-up classes** will be granted in any of our other classes to make up for classes you cannot attend (!)

Holidays:

There are **no classes on Public Holidays and long weekends**. Courses are broken down into terms with short holiday periods in between. These holidays have all been taken into consideration with the class schedules and course duration, and monthly payments are not adjusted for holiday periods. Each course consists of a certain amount of classes, and for those who prefer to pay the course fees off on a monthly basis - the total cost of your course fees are paid off in equal monthly installments, and not calculated at the amount of classes you have each month. Some months are affected by public holidays, our term holiday periods, and long weekends and other months not but the total course is paid off in equal installments.

Missing classes: PLEASE READ THIS SECTION VERY CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING UP FOR OUR COURSES!!

Where possible, please try to arrange your holidays to fall in with the Über Glam holiday periods so you don't miss out on any classes during your course. Work can be provided for homework but classes that are not attended will be forfeited at the student's own expense. **No catch-up classes will be granted** to make up for any missed classes and **no refunds will be issued for any missed classes**.


Students can unfortunately also **not attend on different days** than the days he/she signed up for. **Spaces in other classes are reserved for other students** so unfortunately if you can not attend the class you've signed up for, for any reason whatsoever, then that class is forfeited at your own expense. Should you miss classes for long periods of time without payment or notification of absence, it will be assumed that you have dropped out and we reserve the right to cancel your membership, and the student will still be held liable for payment of the full balance of the course.

Students may also not skip classes to save money – the classes are not offered on a “pay-as-you-go” basis - full payments are due for the full cost of the course you have signed up for, whether you attend all classes or not.

Should a student not finish a course due to missing classes, arrangements can be made for a course extension, at the student's expense. In this case the student will need to book and pay for a full extra term though, as we can unfortunately not place a student for just 1 or 2 extra lessons in a new term to finish off a course.

Location:

We are based in Unit 13&14 Sunpark, 178 Smit Street, Fairland. It is on the corner of Smit street and 5th Ave in Fairland, Gauteng close to the Beyers Naudé turn-off, and about 5 minutes from Cresta Shopping Centre. (see map below)



Courses:

- **Ladies Wear Design and Construction (+40 classes)**

The ladies wear design and construction course consists of a combination of sewing and patternmaking. There are 3 different levels of Ladies wear Design and Construction, each consisting of 40 classes. You may choose to do all of them or only the one/s that interest you.

Beginner: Skirts and shirts (+40 classes)

Intermediate: Lined jackets and pants (+40 classes)

Advanced: Evening and Wedding dresses and bridal accessories (+40 classes)

Different items of clothing and different design features will be done throughout the course. Eg. You will learn how to make patterns and sew different clothing items, how to adapt the patterns to create different basic styles eg to include pleats, flare, different types of sleeves, collars, etc. (refer to course content for more info)

- **Ladies Stretch wear Design & Construction (+40 classes)**

Level: Beginner to Advanced

Learn to sew and make patterns for various stretch wear items. (refer to course content for more info)

- **Ladies Lingerie & Sleepwear Design & Construction (+-40 classes) *NEW***

Level: Beginner to Advanced

Learn to sew and make patterns for various ladies under garments and sleepwear (refer to course content for more info)

- **Ladies Lingerie Design & Construction (+-40 classes) *NEW***

Level: Beginner to Advanced

Learn to sew and make patterns for various ladies under garments (refer to course content for more info)

- **Ladies Beachwear & Resortwear Design & Construction (+-40 classes) *NEW***

Level: Beginner to Advanced

Learn to sew and make patterns for various swimwear, beachwear and resortwear items for ladies (refer to course content for more info)

- **Ladies Swimwear Design & Construction (+-20 classes) *NEW***

Level: Beginner to Advanced

Learn to sew and make patterns for various ladies swimwear items. (refer to course content for more info)

- **Children's wear Design & Construction (+-40 classes)**

Level: Beginner to Advanced

The children's wear design and construction can be done for boys or girls and consists of a combination of sewing and patternmaking, (refer to course content for more info)

- **Men's wear Design & Construction (+-60 classes)**

Level: Beginner to Advanced

The men's wear Design & Construction consists of a combination of sewing and patternmaking of various clothing items for men. (refer to course content for more info). This is our longest course, and the learner starts with the beginner items (eg. a Tshirt) to advanced items (eg. a tailored suit)

- **Design & Construction Combination Course (+-40 classes)**

Level: Beginner to Advanced

Students may select specific Patternmaking and Sewing projects from our different Design & Construction courses that interest them to create their own Design & Construction Combination Course to suit their needs.

- **Fashion Illustration (+-20 classes) Level: Beginner**

Learn how to do fashion drawings and illustrations, i.e. how to give life to your own creations on paper and in different mediums such as paint, pencil, markers, etc. You will learn how to depict different fabrics, and how to professionally present your collection with an inspiration board, fabric swatches etc (for entering fashion competitions, or work proposals.) You'll also learn how to do technical drawings (flats) which is a requirement for clothing manufacture and entering competitions.

The use of my materials in class is included. You may purchase your own materials if you wish to work on this at home as well but we recommend to try our different materials out first before deciding what to buy for yourself. The mounting material for the final presentation of your collection is **not included** as this should be your own choice and should complement the "look" of your collection.

- **3Dimensional design: (+-20 classes)**

Level: Beginner to Advanced

Learn how to create texture and detail with fabric, and make a few accessories such as a fascinator, flowers, bows, appliqué, beading, fabric printing etc. (refer to course content for more info)

- **Handbag course (+- 20 classes)**

Level: Beginner to Advanced

The hand bag course is an exciting extension to our 3Dimensional design course. In this course you will learn to sew a variety of fabric hand bags, from a tote bag to a classy clutch bag. (refer to course content for more info)

- **Home accessories course (+- 20 classes / +-40 classes) *NEW***

Level: Beginner to Advanced

Choose between our option of sewing only, or sewing as well as patternmaking.

Learn to make various items for your home, from scatter cushions to roman blinds and curtains. (refer to course content for more info)

- **Open Class: (minimum booking of 1 x full term, minimum 1 x class per week
+-10 classes, +-20 classes, +-30 classes or +-40 classes**

Level: Beginner to Advanced

For the Open Class you do not follow a specific syllabus. In this class you are free to work on any items that you wish to and need assistance with. You may use this class opportunity to work on your own clothing range, client orders or any preferred project. You may do either just patternmaking, sewing, both, or you may work on any creative things such as bags, belts, jewellery, etc selected from our other courses

(The fees for this course is a little cheaper than the others, because it **excludes all materials used**. Each student works on their own choice of items with their own fabrics and materials for this to class, etc)

The Open Class option is perfect for those who are simply just looking for a hobby, new recreational skill or in the process of starting up his/her own business/clothing label and needs guidance and mentorship with certain projects.

- **Course extension (minimum booking of 1 x full term, minimum 1 x class per week)
+-10 classes, +-20 classes, +-30 classes or +-40 classes**

Students may extend their course if they didn't finish and wish to complete. The Course Extension is charged at the same monthly rate as the Open Class and includes the fabrics, paper and trimmings that were included in the cost of the course originally.

Registrations:

If you are interested in joining us you can either register online or you can just complete and email or fax your registration form to us, with a copy of your ID and registration fee (first month's fee). Registrations are not completed without payment of your registration fee and the classes will be filled up accordingly. No space will be kept for any students without completion of their registrations.

For manual registrations:

1. To register manually, complete your registration form and send this to me by email or fax together with a copy of your ID and registration fee.
2. a) Monthly payments - The registration fee (your first month's fee) is payable to book your place for your class/es.
b) Full payment – the discounted amount is payable to book your space for the full duration of the course.

For online registrations:

1. Go to our website www.uberglam.co.za
2. Click on the courses tab or follow this direct link <http://www.uberglam.co.za/courses>
3. Click on the course you are interested in signing up for
4. Click the dropdown arrow of the course to open up the information of the course
5. Select the "Enroll Today" button at the bottom
6. If you are registering for only one course then choose the payment option (It will give you the option to either pay in monthly installments or the full payment with an automatic discount applicable to the course that you are registering for)
7. If you are registering for more than one course or would like to order accessories (kit items) as well, then complete step 3 – 6 for all of them first
8. If you are done with your order then go to the checkout/cart
9. Check that your order is correct. The fees for "monthly payments" are automatically calculated on **1 class per week** - if you are signing up for **2 or more classes per week** then change your "**quantity**" to the amount of classes you would like to attend per week, and click the "**Update order**" button - the invoice will then be amended accordingly.
10. Complete the personal information on the checkout page (this serves as your online registration form)
11. Click the checkout button at the bottom - On the checkout it will give you the option to pay by eft or via Payfast (debit/credit card payments).

You will now automatically receive the applicable invoice/payment notifications for your records.

Please note, your registration process is not complete until your payment has been received. If your payment has not been received within 72 hours, your registration will automatically be deleted from our system, and you will need to complete a new registration.
