Are you dreaming of being SA's next Top Designer, simply looking for a new and exciting skill or design hobby or want to enhance your existing sewing, patternmaking or fashion design skills? Look no further, UberGlam School of Fashion is ready to instruct you in the art of creating dazzling clothing and accessories to suit your individual needs!

Fashion design, patternmaking and sewing sound like crafts that need advanced skills, but at ÜberGlam we bring out the artist and skill in any aspiring designer. We provide a relaxed and friendly, yet professional atmosphere with the focus on skills development and preparing students practically for those who want to start their own business or those who simply want to learn a new hobby or skill.

We offer full time or part time courses in sewing and patternmaking of all types of ladies wear, men's wear and children's wear, accessories and fashion illustrations. Our courses are flexible and specifically aimed at individuals who are eager to learn the skill of fashion design and sewing without the stress of exams and overdue projects. Our classes are kept small and intimate and we work with each individual at their own level and pace to ensure maximum learning and personal attention, so you never have to worry about waiting for or falling behind the rest of the class.

From teenagers to pensioners, everybody above the age of 10yrs is welcome at ÜberGlam. Whether you're a beginner or advanced learner, a working professional, teen, stay-at-home mom, upcoming young designer or foreigner – anyone with a passion to learn about fashion will fit in with our mix of students and may join our fashion design school.

If you're a practicing designer or current design student at another fashion institute, you can also benefit from our courses and relaxed atmosphere where you can get practical assistance and ask questions, consult with peers, learn new skills and solve issues regarding your design projects, client orders and design and fitting difficulties without any pressure.

From basic sewing classes to patternmaking classes to advanced fashion design classes, one of our courses will appeal to you. You are also welcome to visit and browse through our website www.uberglam.co.za and join us to discover your inner artist and designer.

Courses:

Students may start any of our courses at the beginning of any of our terms. You may choose to do all our courses, or only the one/s that interest you, depending on your personal budget and preference.

- **Open Class**

No specific course syllabus –choose your own projects

Select 10, 20, 30 or 40 x classes

Level: Beginner to Advanced

The Open Class is perfect for those who are simply just looking for a hobby, new recreational skill or guidance with specific items, ie you are free to work on any projects you need assistance with- ranging from any patternmaking and sewing of outfits or accessories for yourself or your home, to customer orders or your own clothing label.

This is our cheapest course option because it **excludes all materials and paper used**. Students work on their own choice of projects with their own fabrics and materials or can purchase additionally from us as needed.

Minimum booking of 1 x full term (+-10 x weeks)

10 x classes = 1 x class per week.

20 x classes = 2 x classes per week for 1 x term **or** 1 x class per week for 2 x terms.

30 x classes = 3 x classes per week for 1 x term **or** 1 x class per week for 3 x terms.

40 x classes = 4 x classes per week for 1 x term **or** 1 x class per week for 4 x terms or 2 x classes per week for 2 x terms

- **Design and Construction Courses**

These courses all follow a set syllabus, except for the Design & Construction Combination Course.

Level: Beginner to Advanced

The Design & Construction courses consist of a combination of sewing and patternmaking. Various items of clothing and different design features will be handled throughout each course. Eg. Learning how to make patterns and sew different clothing garments and adapting the patterns to include panels, pleats, flare, different types of sleeves, collars, etc.

- **Ladies Wear Beginner course (DC 1):** Skirts & shirts (+-40 x classes)
- **Ladies Wear Intermediate course (DC 2):** Lined jackets & trousers (+-40 x classes)
- **Ladies Wear Advanced course (DC 3):** Evening, wedding dresses & bridal accessories (+-40 x classes)
- **Ladies Stretch Wear Course:** Learn to sew & draft patterns for various stretch wear items (+- 40 x classes)
- **Ladies Lingerie Course:** Learn to sew & draft patterns for various ladies under garments (+- 20 x classes)
- **Ladies Lingerie & Sleepwear Course:** Learn to sew and make patterns for various ladies under garments and sleepwear (+-40 x classes)
- **Ladies Swimwear Course:** Learn to sew and make patterns for various swimwear items (+- 20 x classes)
- **Ladies Beachwear & Resort Wear Course:** Learn to sew and make patterns for various swimwear & beachwear items (+-40 x classes)
- **Children's Wear Course:** Learn to sew and make patterns for children, either boys and/or girls, depending on your preference (+- 40 x classes)
- **Men's wear Course – Informal Wear:** Beginner to advanced patternmaking and sewing of men's casual clothing (+- 40 x classes)
- **Men's wear Course – Formal Wear:** Beginner to advanced patternmaking and sewing of men's classic suits (+- 40 x classes)
- **Design & Construction Combination:** *No specific course syllabus –choose your own projects*
Select your own of items of preference from our various Design & Construction courses
(10, 20, 30 or 40 x classes)

- **Design Course for Teens**

Level: Beginner to Advanced
+- 20 x classes

For young teens aged 10 to 17 years. You will learn to sew a scatter cushion, lined tote bag, circle skirt, leggings, shorts, t-shirt / t-shirt dress, gown / onesie and hoodie.

- **Fashion Illustration Course**

Level: Beginner to Advanced
+- 20 x classes

Bring your own creations to life on paper, using different mediums such as paint, pencil, markers, etc. You will learn how to draw and color your designs, how to depict different fabrics and how to present your collection with an inspiration board, fabric swatches for entering fashion competitions, or work proposals.

You'll also learn how to do technical drawings (flats) which is a requirement for clothing manufacture and entering competitions.

- **Handbag Sewing Course**

Level: Beginner to Advanced
+- 20 x classes

In this course you will learn to sew a variety of fabric handbags with your domestic sewing machine, ranging from a classic lined tote bag to pencil bag, to an elegant framed clutch bag.

- **Home accessories Course**

Level: Beginner to Advanced
+- 20 x classes (Sewing)
+- 40 x classes (Sewing & Patternmaking)

Learn to make various items for your home, from scatter cushions to roman blinds, beddings and curtains.

- **Course extension (only available to existing students who did not finish one of the syllabus courses).**
Select 10, 20, 30 or 40 x classes

The Course Extension is charged at the same monthly rate as the Open Class. However, no extra charges for fabric, paper and trimmings etc will apply to course extensions.

Minimum booking of 1 x full term (+-10 x weeks)

10 x classes = 1 x class per week.

20 x classes = 2 x classes per week for 1 x term or 1 x class per week for 2 x terms.

30 x classes = 3 x classes per week for 1 x term or 1 x class per week for 3 x terms.

40 x classes = 4 x classes per week for 1 x term or 1 x class per week for 4 x terms or 2 x classes per week for 2 x terms.

Course duration:

At ÜberGlam School of Fashion you can set your own pace and work within your budget. Each class is for 2.5 hours, and our minimum booking is for 1 x full term. Courses can either be done one at a time, or a few simultaneously, or a course can be completed in a shorter period by signing up for more than 1 x class per week depending on your personal budget and time availability.

The duration of each course is based on the total number of classes of the course and the number of weekly lessons you register for. Eg. a 40 x lesson course will take 1 year if you book 1 x class a week, or can be done in 6 months if you do 2 x classes per week or 3 x months if you sign up for 4 x classes per week.

If you sign up for more than 1 x class per week, the monthly fees are increased to the number of classes you sign up for per week so that the full amount is paid up by the time you finish with your course.

School Terms & Holidays:

You may start any course at the start of any of our terms.

There are **no classes on Public Holidays and long weekends**. Courses are equally divided into school terms with short holiday periods in between.

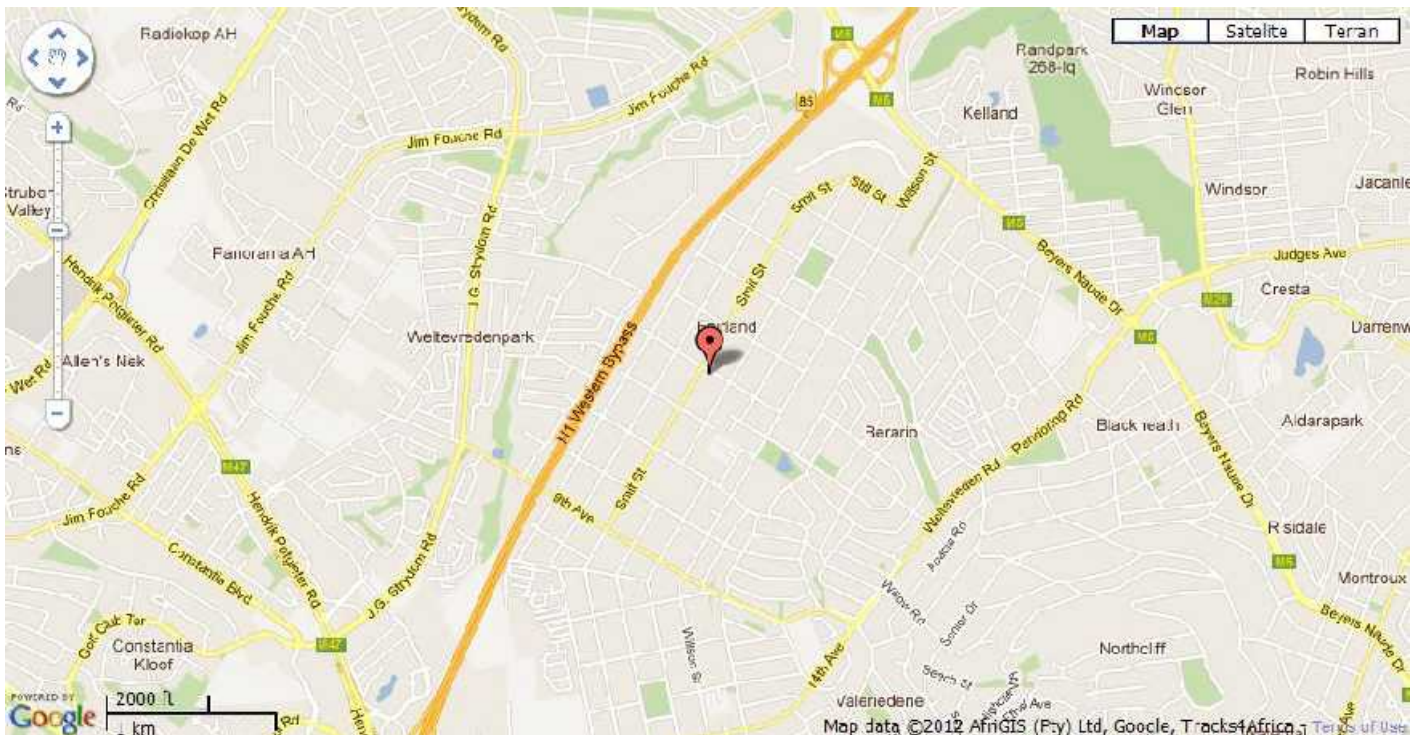
